#### **DJUSD FACILITIES MASTER PLAN**

- The Facilities Master Plan is a strategy for growth that identifies a vision for the upcoming 10 to 15 years.
- In 2017-18, DJUSD underwent an extensive outreach process to produce a Facility Master Plan.
- This report provide an addendum to the Facilities Master Plan to specifically address Early Childhood Education facility considerations

## **REQUISITE FACILITIES**

- The expansion of Transitional Kindergarten and proposed addition of Extended-Day Kindergarten will require the addition of 18 age-appropriate classrooms in DJUSD.
- This will include two additional age-appropriate classrooms at each elementary school site with the exception of César Chávez which requires one additional classroom and Birch Lane which requires five additional classrooms.

#### **CDE TITLE 5 REQUIREMENTS**



#### **Classroom Guidelines**

- <u>Size:</u> Classroom size not less than 1,350 square feet, (including restrooms, storage, teacher preparation, wet and dry areas)
- <u>Supervision:</u> Kindergarten classrooms supervision of play yards and all areas of the classroom
- Play Yard Design: Provides a variety of activities for development of large motor skills
- Proximity to Dropoff: Close to parent drop-off & bus loading areas
- <u>Flexibility:</u> Storage, casework and learning stations are functionally designed for use in free play and structured activities
- <u>Age Appropriate:</u> Windows, marker boards, sinks, drinking fountains and furniture are appropriate heights for K/TK-age students.
- **Restrooms:** Are self-contained within the classroom.

#### DESIGN DEVELOPMENT PHASE

Pending Board approval of the Facilities Master Plan addendum and identification of capital funding, formal design work will begin.

Final building placement is subject to change based on additional considerations that will arise during the design phase.

Additional community outreach will include adjacent neighbors regarding final location recommendations per DJUSD Outreach protocol.



#### **ANTICIPATED FACILITIES CAPITAL COST**

It is anticipated that the total cost of providing an additional 18 classrooms is approximately \$32,000,000.

This cost estimate is preliminary because the formal design process has not begun.



Construction for the new ECE classrooms will likely occur in phases. Phase One would encompass school sites that currently have the space available to accommodate new buildings. Phase Two would incorporate the sites that may require additional location prep prior to the start of construction.



## PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Each project will take approximately one year to construct.

#### **SUMMER 2024**

Phase 1 construction with an anticipated occupancy of Fall 2025.

#### **SUMMER 2025**

Phase 2 construction with an anticipated occupancy of Fall 2026.



## FUNDING FOR THE ECE INITIATIVE





The construction of additional
Transitional Kindergarten/Kindergarten
classrooms is currently an unfunded
initiative.
