Use of pesticide/herbicide may not be required depending on conditions. No pesticides are used in individual classroom garden plots unless specifically requested by the person responsible for maintaining the garden and are on the approved Pesticide List 2023-24.

Prior to every application, signs are posted at the school site indicating the date of intended application and the pesticide/herbicide to be used. Parents or guardians may register to receive individual prior notification of pesticide/herbicide applications. Those listed on this registry receive notification of intended pesticide/herbicide application at least 72 hours before pesticides/herbicides are applied.
